The Labrador Retrievers on this International official White List have had their DNA tested as clear of the mutated gene for Centronuclear Myopathy. This page is the only official list of clear dogs available.

Owners have received an email notification with an Alfort School of Veterinary Medicine individual certificate prior to their Labrador being placed on this list. Canines not passing are not listed and kept confidential at the Alfort School of Veterinary Medicine.

The purpose of the White-List is:

- For breeding decisions
- To check historic CNM clearances in pedigrees
- To check CNM clearances on littermates
- To check CNM clearances on parent's of a pup being considered for purchase.
